Our district's crisis response team is working hard to problem solve several issues with so many district staff who live in Chilliwack. If there are staffing shortages this week, it is possible Learning Assistance (Mrs. Hildebrand), ELL (Mrs. Thiessen) Physical Education (with Mr. Lande), and Library Learning Commons (Mrs. Chow) will be cancelled as they will need to cover missing classroom teachers as TTOC's may not be available this week. Teachers will be able to teach their own Physical Education during scheduled time if it must be cancelled.

We will be back to face-to-face learning starting tomorrow Monday, November 22nd. Friday, November 26th is a Pro-D, and classes will not be in session.
