Hello families!

Kids are eager to share the books they are reading, explain their math to me or have a check in and chat as I peek in on their learning. We continue to work on using our 'helping hands' to solve conflict on the playground here at Auguston Traditional. During our Friday Friends whole school buddy time we have been talking about using this valuable tool when we have a disagreement. We hold our hand open and work our way through the steps:

- 1 say 'stop, I don't like it when you _____, because ______'. It's everyone's responsibility to stop when they are asked to stop and we are working on that, too,
- 2 Ignore the behaviour,
- 3 Walk away from the situation,
- 4 find something else to do or someplace else to be, and
- 5 seek help from an adult on duty.



Not only does this strategy help our students have a voice and advocate for their needs, but it also frees up our duty parents and teachers to deal with any bigger issues that may arise. We have 'helping hands' posters up around the school and will continue to work on this throughout the year.

Fundraising updates

Earlier this year we had a number of fundraising initiatives that we took part in as a school. Our online fundraisers collected \$280 for the Terry Fox Foundation and \$116.50 for Cops for Cancer. We will use our 'No Uni for a Toonie' day funds to top both those donations up to \$500 from our school and we will also be donating \$250 from our 'No Uni' funds to both the food bank and the Veterans fund. Our little school is making a huge difference!!!

These bins are a hit and give the kids access to other areas on our playground to have fun while being creative and building skills around sharing and taking turns. School Affordability Grant

Recently the Ministry of Education and Child Care announced that it would be allocating \$60 million in one-time funding to school districts to increase food security for students and their families, and to support students, parents, and guardians with affordability concerns during the 2022/23 school year. Our school has been allocated \$2,586 to support family's needs for meal and food security, school supplies, fee waivers or school clothing. Front Door Unlocked – Visitor/Volunteer Sign In

The front door outside the office is now **UNLOCKED** (if it's unlocked you will be able to press the knob down to enter - it may occasionally be locked, and a doorbell may be placed outside if Mrs. Tait has stepped away from the office or is on break/lunch). The other outside doors to the building will remain locked.



Parents and Visitors are asked to SIGN IN and wear a visitor/volunteer tag in order to enter onsite, and, if volunteering, to have completed the Volunteer Process.

The most important 'job' we are charged within a school is to keep everyone safe. In order to do this, we need to know at all times who is in our building. It keeps our students, staff, and parents safe! Please make sure you stop at the office, sign in and receive a visitor/volunteer tag before you head towards your child's class (or area of the building you are visiting/volunteering in). By having everyone sign in, we obtain a secure count and understanding of who is in our building. So please **STOP** and remember this procedure when you enter the front entrance of our school.



On Time for School

Consistent attendance sets habits for a lifetime. Punctuality is important in order that each child receive the maximum benefits that come from consistent, daily, sequential instruction. The student learns the value of respecting the time and effort of others and the importance of keeping commitments.

Students need to be here on time **between 8:30-8:40am** every day so that their learning can be effective and efficient. Thank you for your assistance with this.

Absent or Late Students

On our school website you will find a tab "Report Absence or Late" for Safe Arrival: https://www.abbyschools.ca/safe-arrival. Please use this option to report your child absent or late (unless more than 3 days absent).

- For students who will be absent for more than 3 days or going on extended vacation, please notify you child's <u>teacher</u> and the <u>school office</u>.
- If a student arrives at 8:40am or later, they
 MUST check in at the office.
- If a student is leaving school early, parents MUST sign their child out at the office.
- Students MUST be picked up between 2:37 2:47pm while there is supervision.

Appointments

If possible, please try to schedule appointments or activities for your child **outside of school hours** to help protect instructional time.

Early Morning Arrivals to School

Please understand that adult supervision of students does not begin until 8:30am. As the mornings become darker, we are not aware of students being in and around the school especially if they are on the playground. We understand that as parents work commitments often involve leaving early. If this is the case, we ask if it is possible for your children to go to friend's home and come to school closer to the time when supervision begins. We appreciate your cooperation with this matter. Safety of children is paramount.

Messages for your child and/or your child's teacher

If possible, messages for your child and/or your child's teacher about after school pick up, etc. need to be communicated **PRIOR to drop off or via the school planner** to minimize disruptions to instructional time.

Dropping off something for your child

In order to minimize class disruption, please do not take items directly to your child's classroom (or portable). **Please drop them off at the office** and they will be delivered to your child (or your child will be paged to come and collect them.)

Thank you to parents who have set up your schoolcash account and utilize this option. You will be receiving reminders and messages about new items being added to your child's 'cart' when field trips and other items arise. SchoolCashOnline limits the amount of cash/cheques handled in schools, reduces paperwork, and results in more focused instructional time in the classroom. The Abbotsford School District now uses SchoolCashOnline for all schools. With SchoolCashOnline, parents have the convenient and secure option of paying for school items using their credit card online, 24/7.
