- we currently have 350 students enrolled at our school

- We also have an extra cohort of itinerant teachers that support our students in other ways like speech and language, Indigenous teachings, English Language Learning and counselling supports, as well as other District specialists assigned to our school
- We are lucky to have our very own St. John's Ambulance certified Therapy Dog team. Tess comes on Tuesdays to listen to students read and enjoy a few treats as payment.

Overall, we have an amazing group of adults that are dedicated to working together to support all of our students in finding success in their own way. We are pretty proud of the school we have and love that you are here with us on our learning journey this year.

#### Parking concerns

Once again, we are having some struggles with our 'no parking' zones along Stephen Leacock Drive out front of the school. Please be mindful of our students' safety by not parking near marked crosswalks or in any of our 'no parking' areas. These spots are part of the engineered planning of our community and are in place to allow for open sight lines as cars approach the crosswalk. This allows all drivers to see if students or families are about to cross and gives them enough time to safely stop for them. Student safety is a priority for us, and we need your help to ensure that students are able to cross safely.



We have had a few concerns with people parking 'just for a minute' or stopping where they shouldn't

and have had numerous complaints to our City Bylaw Enforcement. Officers will be onsite regularly and will hand out tickets to cars parked in those areas. We will also try to put out cones to deter people from parking near to our crosswalks. We appreciate your continued support in this and your kindness in dealing with all of our community safety needs.

Consent forms are ONLINE in SchoolCash. Consent includes Request for Email Address Consent, Google for Education, Photograph/Video and Media, Permission off Grounds and for Field Trips.

You will be receiving reminders and messages about new items being added to your child's 'cart' when field trips and other items arise. A suggestion is to purchase a prepaid credit card to make purchases if you are concerned about online shopping. The district site is a secure site which does not hold account information.

SchoolCashOnline limits the amount of cash/cheques handled in schools, reduces paperwork, and results in more focused instructional time in the classroom. The Abbotsford School District now uses SchoolCashOnline for all schools. With SchoolCashOnline, parents have the convenient and secure option of paying for school items using their credit card online, 24/7.
