We truly appreciate the support that Lisa Kantas (LSS one day a week), Anita Dhaliwal (Teacher in Charge one day a week) and Andrea Janzen (four days of Learning Assistance and one day a week in grade 5) provided for us over the last number of months to help me get the job done. Expansion project updates:

• We have a floor!!! Our project is starting to come together and we had a very exciting day last week when the concrete was poured and finished giving us our ground floor. We can start to see where things like the staircase, the elevator, and the four ground floor classrooms will be and are looking forward to the next step when we get some walls up!

• Edge Photography:

We were notified last week that our school photos, taken by Edge Photography, were part of a data breach on their servers. Though we don't use their yearbook service, we asked and it was confirmed that our student photos were part of the breach. Other identifiable information was not a part of the breach. Cyber Incident Related to School Yearbooks

We have been informed that the yearbook software service provider used by our school, Creator Studio Pro, has been the subject of a cyber incident. Photos that were uploaded to this platform for our school's 2022/23 and 2023/24 yearbooks may have been compromised. This means that your child's photo may have been accessed in the incident. We are advised that only photos have been accessed, and **no other identifying information** such as school, grade, name or location were affected by the cyber incident.
