1. Principal Report:

- Land Acknowledgement We acknowledge the Abbotsford School District is located on the traditional and unceded territory of the Sema:th First Nation and Mathxwi First Nation. With this, we respect the longstanding relationships that Indigenous Nations have to this land, as they are the original caretakers.
- Staffing 24 teachers overall for 15 classes plus support (LCC, Library, LLS, PE etc). New to us is Mrs. Menard in LSS, Mr. Warkentin sharing PE, Mrs. Wiens sharing Grade 3/4, Mrs Janzen sharing both Grade 4 classes and Ms. Kennedy in Grade 2. We also started the year with 8 EA's this year!
- Numbers 337 students in 15 classrooms
- Expansion Project getting to look like a real school! Floors are going in, cabinets
 are being delivered and installed this week, lights are up, some ceilings are in,
 elevator is getting closer to being installed. Still aiming for a move in after Spring
 Break
- **FSA's** Starting soon for our Grade 4 students. Snapshot of reading, writing and numeracy proficiency. These province wide assessments will be completed between Oct 1 and Nov 9.
- **Therapy Dog** Tess is back and working with kids on Tuesday mornings through the PAWS for Reading program through St. Johns Ambulance
- Board Presentation went well! Kids did great. One book/One School, Math Mania and Sprinkles of Kindness Donuts were presented by the kids and Kris to the school board.
- After School Program run through Abbotsford Community Schools Society and

are starting in late October. Our Fall sessions are Basketball for Grade % boys, DOVE for Grade % girls, Outdoor Explorers for K/1's and Science Exploration for Grade 2/3's. Each program runs for 6 weeks after school one day a week.

- **Christmas Concert -** something is happening! Not sure what yet but there will be a Christmas concert. Staging is booked for last week in December.
- **Digital Devices in School** there will be an update added to our code of conduct and shared with families once it's reviewed by staff
