Grade 5s to Middle School


Grade 5s in Clayburn's catchment for middle school will be receiving registration forms after the break.

Games will be after Spring Break, on Wednesdays with location to be determined. All players can play on these days. Playing from 3-4:15pm.


- Boys will play April 9 and 23

Thank you to parents who have set up your schoolcash account and utilize this option. You will be receiving reminders and messages about new items being added to your child's 'cart' when field trips and other items arise. A suggestion is to purchase a **prepaid credit card** to make purchases if you are concerned about online shopping. The district site is a secure site which does not hold account information.

SchoolCashOnline limits the amount of cash/cheques handled in schools, reduces paperwork, and results in more focused instructional time in the classroom. The Abbotsford School District now uses SchoolCashOnline for all schools. With SchoolCashOnline, parents have the convenient and secure option of paying for school items using their credit card online, 24/7.
